

**VALUE ADJUSTMENT BOARD RESOLUTION 09-116**

**Resolution extending time for filings Requests for  
Reconsideration of Special Magistrate's decision  
To the Value Adjustment Board**

WHEREAS, Resolution R-08-270, setting up the Board local internal policies, provides a process for taxpayers to request reconsideration by the Value Adjustment Board of the Special Magistrates recommendation relative to a given petition; and

WHEREAS, this resolution provides that the filing of such written requests were to have been accomplished within 10 days of the Magistrate's filing of such final recommendation with the Clerk, and it was subsequently determined that this process would be burdensome to the public by establishing different filing deadlines based upon the individual Magistrate and requiring the Petitioner to monitor the Clerks office to determine exactly what date the recommendation was filed; and

WHEREAS, it was determined by the Chair, The Board Attorney and Clerk that a more uniform process should be put in place whereby all Petitioners were given notice at the same time of a uniform deadline of April 17, 2009 for the filing of such requests, and it is the desire of the Board to amend, ratify and confirm the Resolution and all actions taken to accomplish this uniform notice to Petitioners of the time frame within which to file.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Value Adjustment Board of Manatee County that it was and is appropriate and in the best interest of the Public to modify the rules for filing requests for reconsideration to the Board as set forth above; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all actions taken by staff to implement the new filing process and deadlines taken prior to the date hereof to accomplish same are hereby ratified and confirmed by the Board, and the process is hereby deemed to be incorporated into Resolution R-08-270 as if originally set forth therein.
