COUNTY COMMISSION INITIATED

Z- 88

Amend the A GENERAL AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT, as amended by Z-82, by adding a paragraph 7 to read as follows:

7. Upon termination of any Special Exception for a mobile home as a residence in an A GENERAL AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT which was granted prior to the adoption of Z-82 for a parcel of land less than ten acres in area the owner may apply for an extension of such Special Exception within thirty days of its termination. The granting of such extension shall be for a period not to exceed two years, at the end of which time the mobile home must be removed from the premises.

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
